In particular, she has a strong focus in understanding protein-protein interactions using structural biology. Furthermore, she has a profound expertise in structural and functional biochemistry as well as drug design. She is a biomedical scientist working in the area of apoptosis and associated diseases such as cancer and neurodegeneration. Her latest studies will be presented.
